

Robert Gremley is a credit and lending expert with over 50 years in banking. Mr. Gremley most recently served as a Director of New Century Bank from its inception as a de novo bank in 1999 until August of 2008. He was previously President of American Midwest Bank in Melrose Park, having worked his way up from Vice President during his 15 year tenure. He also served as Chief Lending Officer and Executive Vice President of South Shore Bank, where he provided substantial guidance to a struggling bank group shortly after it was purchased.
